

COVID-19 CASE STUDY

One of the poorest family we witnessed in Howlia Village, Tehatta Block is Mr. Gourav Mondal, Aged 28, Christian from the village of Howlia, Dhakinpara. He is an uneducated and rickshaw puller, though he is not healthy to pull the rickshaw rather sick most of the days. Since he is a sick man most of the days he is at home lying down sick without any proper medication due to lack of money to buy the medicine or to meet the doctor. Due to lack of medicines and lack of proper healthy food he is on bed most of the days.

He has a wife named Sikha Mondal, who is Hindu, aged 24. She is hailing from nearby village whose parents also are very poor. She is also an uneducated and lean and pale looking and also sick most of the days. Due to lack of income in the family she is also in the bed most of the days without any medication or doctors' advice. She cooks once a while when husband goes for pulling rickshaw and earns some money, otherwise they have to depend on the alms of the people for their daily food.

They have two pretty children. The name of the boy is Akash Mondal, aged 7 and younger sister named Mallika Mondal. Both of them are at home without going to school.

The condition of their house is very deplorable. Wind, storm and rain keep them always awake. Summer heat never allows them to remain inside. Winter never permits them to sleep.

KCCSS intervened with the support of the Parish Priest of Fr. Arul Rozario and few other local donors able to support them for their daily food Materials required for two months, Cloths, and with some Utensils. We also supplied some medicines and helped them to meet the doctor. Now they are at peace for the moment through our timely support. They are very thankful to the Caritas India who is behind the scene and KCCSS who are directly supported this family.
